**Story structure**: important parts of a story's plot.

- 1. Conflict (problem)- usually introduced in a scene in he beginning of the story.
  - 2. Events
- 3. Resolution (solution)- this happens near the end of the story.

Summarize

**Summarize** - to retell the important parts of the story in your own words.

\*Make sure you put the important parts in the order in which you read them in the story.

**Point of View** - who is telling the story.

\*Third Person - the narrator is observing the events of the story.

\*Third person limited-third person narrator shares ONLY ONE character's thoughts and feelings.

\*Third person omniscient - third person narrator shares thoughts and feelings of ALL characters.

Author's Craft Irony

**Irony -** when something happens that is the opposite of what readers expect.

Ex: In the story of Cinderella, the stepsisters think and act as if they are royalty. In the end, Cinderella is the one that becomes royalty.
