Story Structure

Story structure: important parts of a story's plot.

1. Conflict (problem)- usually introduced in a scene in the beginning of the story.
2. Events
3. Resolution (solution)- this happens near the end of the story.

Target Strategy

Summarize

Summarize - to retell the important parts of the story in your own words.

*Make sure you put the important parts in the order in which you read them in the story.

Point of View - who is telling the story.

***Third Person** - the narrator is observing the events of the story.

***Third person limited**-third person narrator shares ONLY ONE character's thoughts and feelings.

***Third person omniscient** - third person narrator shares thoughts and feelings of ALL characters.

Irony

Irony - when something happens that is the opposite of what readers expect.

Ex: In the story of Cinderella, the stepsisters think and act as if they are royalty. In the end, Cinderella is the one that becomes royalty.
